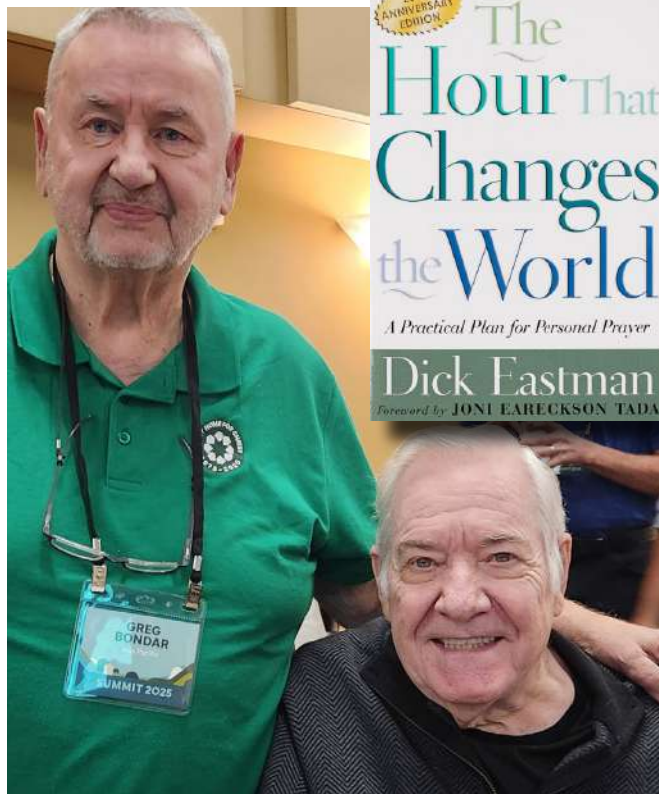

I was very blessed to have met up with Dick Eastman in Colorado Springs last month who is widely acknowledged as having taken the purpose and mission of Every Home for Christ (EHC) globally.

This month, EHC will be holding a **50th Anniversary Prayer Breakfast** with the aim of recognising the ministry that EHC has undertaken in the last 50 years and with the hope that EHC will continue to fulfill Matthew 28:19 in the next 50 years.

Our special guest at this prayer breakfast will be **Dick Eastman** (via Zoom) who will be speaking on the importance of prayer and then leading the first prayer followed by 9 other Prayer Leaders (see later in newsletter).



Dick Eastman's participation has reminded me of his 1978 book called **The Hour That Changes the World**. Its focus is on prayer. In particular, Dick wants to convey the importance of 'prayer' and believes that Christians should devote more time to it. In his book he makes a case for



having a plan, or an outline, that would act as a guide for prayer. He gives several categories that could be used to split up an hour into twelve five-minute sections of prayer.

I have used Dick's method with a great deal of success. I can say with all honesty that having a prayer guide like this helps one to have focus and will enable you to pray for at least an hour without repeating things repeatedly. I am not saying that longer prayers equal better prayers but if you do set aside an hour for prayer and make the effort to meet God in a sincere heart of worship, then this helps you to do so without rambling.

If you are able, please join us at this Prayer Breakfast and hear church and other Christian Leaders speak and pray as EHC enters the next 50 years of carrying Christ to everyone, everywhere and every generation.

May I finish with one of the most challenging statements made by Jesus in **Matthew 26:40 (ESV)**

"And he came to the disciples and found them sleeping. And he said to Peter, 'So, could you not watch with me one hour?'"

Asia Pacific Youth Summit 2025

Empowering a New Generation of Leaders

The Asia Pacific Youth Summit 2025 was a resounding success, bringing together young leaders from across the region in a two-day event at the New South Wales Parliament in Sydney. Delegates were inspired and equipped through keynotes, workshops and prayer, before being formally commissioned as **NexGen Disciple Youth Ambassadors**.

Day One - Roundtable



On 10 September, delegates joined an evening Roundtable MC'd by Suzi Michael. Greg Bondar, National Director of Every Home for Christ, opened the night, followed by a welcome from Hon. John Ruddick MLC. After rapid-fire introductions led by Youth Ambassador Jemima, participants broke into groups to discuss how young people can live out their faith in family, education, politics and community. The session closed with a prayer of commissioning from Ps James Dargin (Wiradjuri Elder).



Day Two - Youth Summit



On 11 September, the official Summit began with worship and vision casting from **NexGen Ambassadors for Australia & New Zealand Jemima and Leon**. Keynotes came from leaders including Keona Praise (Philippines), Christian Malik, Hon. Ash Ambihapahar and Hon. Rachel Merton MLC, covering themes of leadership, community service and courage in the public square.



The highlight came when new **NexGen Ambassadors** were appointed from **Tonga, Samoa, Papua New Guinea, Fiji, Pakistan and the Philippines**, a milestone for expanding the movement's reach. A dynamic panel session followed, with delegates sharing stories of faith and perseverance.

Moving Forward

The Summit marked a defining step for **Every Home for Christ's NexGen Disciples movement**. With six new nations represented, these young leaders are ready to carry Christ into every generation with conviction, vision and courage.

URGENT APPEAL

Supporting Orphan Girls in India

New Sponsorship Program with Unexpected Emergency

Next month, Every Home Global Concern will partner with the D*** Foundation, to launch a new Child Sponsorship Program in India. The program will provide vital support for children attending D*** School, which educates both orphans living on campus and children from surrounding families.

This program was designed to ensure vulnerable children receive quality education, daily care and the hope of a brighter future. But before the launch could take place, an urgent crisis arose: the current girls' dormitory is unsafe, overcrowded and unfit for the children who depend on it.



A Story of Urgent Need

Ten-year-old Am** is one of the children whose life depends on D*** Foundation. Her father murdered her mother and is now in prison, leaving her without family or a safe place to call home. This School became her refuge, a place where staff show care and compassion.

Yet the truth is stark. Girls like Am** are living in cramped quarters never intended for permanent housing. Overcrowding, lack of privacy and poor security weigh heavily on children already burdened by trauma and grief.

Building a dedicated orphan girls' residence is about more than bricks and mortar; it is about restoring dignity, safety and stability. With proper housing, the girls of this school will have the environment they need to heal, grow and thrive.



Why This School Matters

The D*** Foundation runs not only the school but also church and training programs that provide holistic support to children and their communities. Their work offers both education and care to children from low socio-economic backgrounds, ensuring no child is left without opportunity or hope.

The Child Sponsorship Program launching in October will connect sponsors with children from the orphanage and surrounding community, providing for school fees, uniforms, books and daily needs. However, before this vision can grow, we must first secure safe lodging for the orphan girls.



The Cost of Building Safety

An architect's plan has been prepared for a two-level facility. The total cost of construction is outlined below

- Stilt Floor Building: AUD\$41,000, NZD\$45,000, GBP£21,320
- Ground Floor Building: AUD\$69,000, NZD \$75,900, GBP £35,880
- Grand Total: AUD\$110,000, NZD\$121,000, GBP £57,200

A Place to Learn, Grow and Belong: New Benches & Tables for Sri Lanka

At the Hope Centre in Sri Lanka, more and more children are finding a safe space to learn, play and grow through the Every Home Global Concern Child Sponsorship Program. This steady growth is a sign of God's favour and of the faithful support from friends like you.

But with this blessing has come a new challenge. The wooden tables and benches that have served our children for over five years are now broken, unsafe and no longer usable. For children who already face hardship, a simple chair and table to sit at is more than just furniture, it's the foundation of a stable, welcoming environment where they can focus, learn and dream about their future.

- Cost per set: LKR 25,000(≈ AUD \$125 / NZD \$138 / GBP £65)
- Total needed for 26 sets: LKR 650,000 (≈AUD\$3,250/NZD\$3,588/GBP £1,690)

Building a Brighter Future – An Inclusive Playground for Our Preschool in Zambia

For the past three years, preschoolers at our Preschool in Zambia have faced isolation, emotional stress and poor health outcomes due to a lack of creative playtime and proper playground facilities. Without these opportunities, children are missing the chance to develop crucial early childhood skills such as social interaction, resilience and problem-solving.

- Help children living with disabilities experience acceptance and belonging.
- Encourage all children to develop social and interactive skills through play.
- Break down barriers by creating a compassionate environment where empathy, inclusion and new friendships can flourish.



Ab***, aged 10, is one of many children at the Preschool living with a disability. Because of limited opportunities for social and emotional growth, Abel has not been able to progress from preschool to primary school. His low self-esteem and ongoing isolation highlight the urgent need for inclusive play spaces.

Establishing an inclusive playground facility will transform Ab**'s experience and the lives of many other children. It will:

- Foster friendship, communication and confidence.

Playgrounds are more than just recreational spaces, they are places of learning, healing and growth. By building an inclusive playground at the Preschool, we can provide a safe, structured and creative environment for over 200 children aged 2–10 and their families.

Together, we can reduce isolation, promote acceptance and build a brighter, more inclusive future for every child in this Zambian Village.
